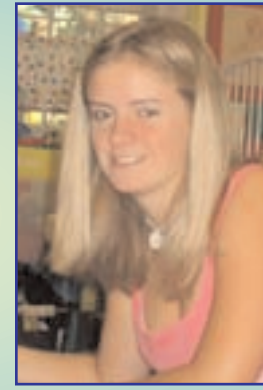


# Sunday School
